Our neighborhood's remaining historic street signs have been fully refurbished, thanks to Mary Leslie's dedication to this complicated process. Two of the signs were removed, repaired and re-installed, and three signs were restored and painted in place. Our thanks to Intown Ace Hardware for providing two new street name plaques at cost! The overall expense of the restoration project was \$2,400, and the neighborhood association was able to contribute \$1,500 thanks to our neighborhood's ongoing support.
