Financial Report (Nick Cortese)

- Current treasury balance of \$4,326.90. Since the February report we have incurred expenses of \$21.17 for web hosting fees and received dues and donations of \$2,023. 104 households have participated in paying dues in 2021, an increase over 2020 and 2019. Note was made about the fact that Gena did not host a block party in the Spring of 2020 nor at Halloween 2020.
- Nick will reach out to neighbors who paid 2021 twice to determine whether they wish a refund or to apply to 2022 dues.

Listserv Report (Paul Cushing)

- Thank you to Lee Pritchard for years of IT mastery
- Discussion of Assistant Listserv Moderator to Paul
- Currently 321 listserv members
- Listsrv at the edge of storage at 90%. Paul mentioned the possibility of enabling compression of photos attached to new posts which would reduce the rate of storage usage going forward. He said he would look into it and report back to the Board. Subsequent to the meeting Paul reported to the Board that he was able to remove some large attachments from 3 or 4 older posts which resulted in storage increasing significantly. As a result, photo compression isn't needed for now and GENA's storage capacity is not a current concern.
- The board discussed recognizing top contributors for their service to the neighborhood.
- Neighbor requested reconsideration of taking neighbors off the listserv after they
 move, and rather to keep them on for a period of time (3 5 years). The board
 discussed and agreed that the listserv should continue to be limited to current
 residents.
